All papers should be submitted electronically via the Online Paper Submission System, which is located at http://cig.iet.unipi.it/isda2009. The format of both the initial submissions and the final accepted papers must be in PDF. All submitted papers will be refereed by experts in the respective fields according to the criteria of originality, significance, quality and clarity.

The authors of accepted papers will have an opportunity to revise their papers and take the referees' comments and suggestions into consideration before submitting the final papers. All accepted papers with paid registration will be included in the Proceedings of ISDA'09. Selected papers will be published in special issues of a selection of International Journals (to be announced).
